

#### Student News Crew 2018-2019

There will be 8-10 spots open on next year's Student News crew for hard-working and motivated students currently in  $6^{th}$  or  $7^{th}$  grade.

**Step 1**: Make sure you meet the grade and conduct/ behavior criteria before applying. Applicants who do not meet this criteria will not be considered.

<u>Grade Criteria</u> – You must consistently maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher.

<u>Conduct Criteria</u> – You must consistently maintain all 4's and 5's in conduct.

<u>Behavior Criteria</u> – You must have a clean discipline record (few to no referrals)

You also have to be willing to work during every single advisory period and almost every week during Falcon Time on Wednesday mornings.

**Step 2**: Fill out and submit the application and get 3 teacher recommendations by the **April 13**<sup>th</sup> **deadline**.

**Step 3**: When contacted, schedule an interview.
