May is Mental Health Awareness Month

Facts: 1 in 5 children ages 13-18 have, or will have a serious mental illness

- 20% of youth ages 13-18 live with a mental health condition
- 11% of youth have a mood disorder (depression)
- 10% of youth have a behavior or conduct disorder
- 8% of youth have an anxiety disorder

Impact

50% of all lifetime cases of mental illness begin by age 14 and 75% by age 24.

Approximately 50% of students age 14 and older with a mental illness drop out of high school.

Pay attention to the **Warning Signs** and seek help:

- Feeling very sad or withdrawn for more than 2 weeks
- Sudden overwhelming fear for no reason, sometimes with a racing heart, physical discomfort or fast breathing.
- Trouble sleeping- (problems falling asleep or sleeping too much)
- Severe mood swings that cause problems in relationships.
- Difficulty concentrating and staying on task.

Please talk to a trusted adult, your teacher(s), school counselor or school social worker if you notice these signs.
