It's almost quarter one midterm, which means gold cards are coming soon! A gold card is a reward issued to students who maintain above a 2.8 GPA and have all 4's and 5's in conduct.

When you have a gold card, you are entitled to the following privileges:

- You may use your gold card as a hall pass. (This pass is unlimited, but it is to be used only with your teacher's permission.)
- You may carry your backpack with you throughout the school day. (You must display your gold card on your backpack using the plastic tag available at the bookstore.)
- You may use your phone or electronic device during lunch.

Gold cards must be carried with you in order for you to receive the privileges listed above. Remember that gold cards are distributed at every midterm and end of quarter. If you didn't earn one this time, there's always next time. Be a good noodle like Spongebob and earn those extra privileges!

NVMS Pro Tip of the Week: *Starting the School Day Off Right*

Hey Falcon fam! Getting frustrated with the breakfast line? Struggling to get to class in the morning? We've heard your complaints, and we're making some changes. The breakfast line is now open to both ladies and gentlemen immediately after the bell rings. The quicker you get to the breakfast line in the morning, the less time you will have to wait. The lines get long when everyone waits until closer to time for class to start to come get breakfast.

Here are a few helpful reminders from your FABULOUS breakfast supervisors to make things run more smoothly:

- We always join the line at the end - no cutting line or sneaking in with your friends. It's rude to those who have been waiting longer than you have.
- Lines should be single file and form up against the cafeteria windows. This helps things move more quickly and leaves a clear walkway for students passing by.
- The breakfast line closes PROMPTLY at 9:17 when the warning bell rings prior to 1st/2nd period. If you are not in line when that bell rings, please just head to class.
