Good Evening Northview Families,

It's hard to believe that this Thursday our students will resume school virtually. While the past couple of weeks have been a whirlwind, we are beyond excited to begin the 2020 - 2021 school year. Understanding that this is a stressful time for many parents, we are working diligently to communicate with you as much as possible so that all of your questions are answered prior to Thursday. That being said, we took some time today to create a 5 part video series that walks our community through the virtual learning experience for students and also provides resources for our parents to help ensure all students are successful during virtual learning. 5 Part Video Series

While we had originally planned on hosting a community forum this Wednesday at 7:00pm, we have elected to go another route to ensure that our community gets the information they need in advance. Rather than hold the originally scheduled forum, we have created a 5 part video series that families can watch by topic to better understanding the virtual learning experience that students will be receiving. The 5 part video series has been uploaded onto Youtube so that families can access them on their own time.
