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Good Morning Falcon Families,

As noted in last week's Parent Updates, we have 3 primary ways in which we will be preparing students who have selected "in-person hybrid" for the return to school. The 3 ways include:

1.) **Advisory** - Teachers will be reviewing updating norms and expectations as well as safety procedures and practices this upcoming week. Students will learn about the traffic patterns in the building, mask expectations, new lunch procedures, etc... These sessions will be important for all students as there are things that have changed that will impact students in grades 6-8.

2.) **Video Tour and Overview** - This past week, Northview administration put together a video tour of the building. This video tour reviews some of our new procedures, takes students on a tour of the building to help them get acclimated and see some of the safety measures that have been taken, and introduces students to the school leadership team. Our hope is that this will serve as a great reminder for 7th and 8th grade students and a great introduction for our 6th grade students.

3.) **Falcon Quest (6th Grade Specifically)** - For our new incoming 6th grade students, we are aware that you did not get the chance to take a tour of the building and visit Northview prior to COVID-19 shutting down schools. That being the case, we will be offering tours this upcoming Monday (10/12) - Wednesday (10/14) to help ensure 6th grade students understand the building, where classes are located, and feel comfortable in the building. Being that students do not have lockers, the event will simply be focused on getting students oriented with the building and their schedules. While these tours are primarily for 6th grade students, new 7th and 8th grade students who would like to sign up may also do so. Please see below to sign up and review how the event will run.

- **Procedures for Falcon Question:**
  - Students **MUST** arrive at the start of the time slot they have selected. There are 10 minutes in-between tour groups, so please be sure you do not arrive too early or too late. If your tour begins at 4:00pm, you should arrive between 3:55pm - 4:00pm and go to Door #5.
  - Parents will drop students off at Door #5 (Northside of Northview Middle School) and wait in their car for the student to finish. The tours will last exactly 20 minutes. Parents will not be permitted to join the tours.
  - Students will be required to properly wear a mask for the duration of their time in the building.
  - Students will be split up and taken on a tour of the building, highlighting key areas, procedures, classrooms, and expectations.

Please note that Falcon Quest is not a requirement, rather an option for incoming 6th grade students (or students new to Northview) to see the building prior to starting on the first day. The virtual tour will also provide very similar information and an overview of the building as

well.
