Zoom Procedures & Protocols for Virtual Learning



- 1. Set your full name as your Zoom username!** To help teachers make sure that all students joining a Zoom class meeting are in the right place, students need to make sure that they are joining with their first and last name as their Zoom username. Students who do not have their full, accurate name displaying may not be admitted to class.
- 2. Be patient in the waiting room!** Teachers will admit students to Zoom meetings at the start of each class period. If students leave and rejoin a meeting or arrive late, they may need to wait for a bit before the teacher is able to admit them to class. Your patience and understanding is appreciated!
- 3. Cameras on, microphones off!** It is expected that all students leave their cameras on throughout the class period unless otherwise directed. This helps teachers make sure that students are focused and engaged and also helps build a virtual sense of community. Additionally, to ensure a distraction-free learning environment, all students should plan to remain muted unless otherwise directed.
- 4. Contribute to a positive learning environment!** Students should be active participants in class and be responsible and respectful in all of their classroom interactions. It is important to remember that all Zoom meetings are recorded, so if students make poor choices with their behavior, there will be disciplinary consequences.

- NORTHVIEW ATHLETICS -

On Monday, August 3rd, the MSDWT School Board passed a resolution to permit the continuation of athletics in Washington Township Schools. Here is what you need to know about the return to play for fall sports at Northview Middle School:

- In an effort to move completely digital, parents are asked to register student athletes through [Eventlink](#) to submit forms. Prior to arriving for tryouts/callouts, athletes and families must fill out all appropriate forms:
 - Franciscan Health Athletic Consent Form
 - IHSA Health History Update Questionnaire
 - 2020-21 IHSA History & Physical Form **UNLESS** you have an athletic physical form on file at the school from the 2019-2020 school year.
 - signed *WTS Protect Athletics Pledge*
- On Wednesday & Thursday, students should wear appropriate athletic attire and **MUST** wear a face mask. Students are strongly urged to bring sports-specific gear, a labeled water bottle, a hand towel and hand sanitizer.
- On Wednesday & Thursday, all student athletes will need to check in for athletic clearance before heading to tryouts or practice. Directions for this process will be provided during Monday's webinar.
